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

Clinical Cancer Research

The Clinical cancer research team strives to empower cancer patients by raising their voice and needs to improve their quality of life and minimize the impact of a cancer diagnosis.



Great examples of our engagement to address patient needs are the Positive and OLIGORARE clinical trials. They address important issues like fertility during breast cancer treatment and increased survival for people with oligometastatic cancer.



Our commitment to involving patients in research is continuously strengthened through our collaborations with other funders (LLS, LUNGevity, Conquer Cancer) and a new approach to on-patent drug repurposing.

We do this by supporting patient advocate participation in the design and discussion of the trials with the medical team from the very beginning with a mechanism called a pre-application grant.






Freedom in Practice


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
